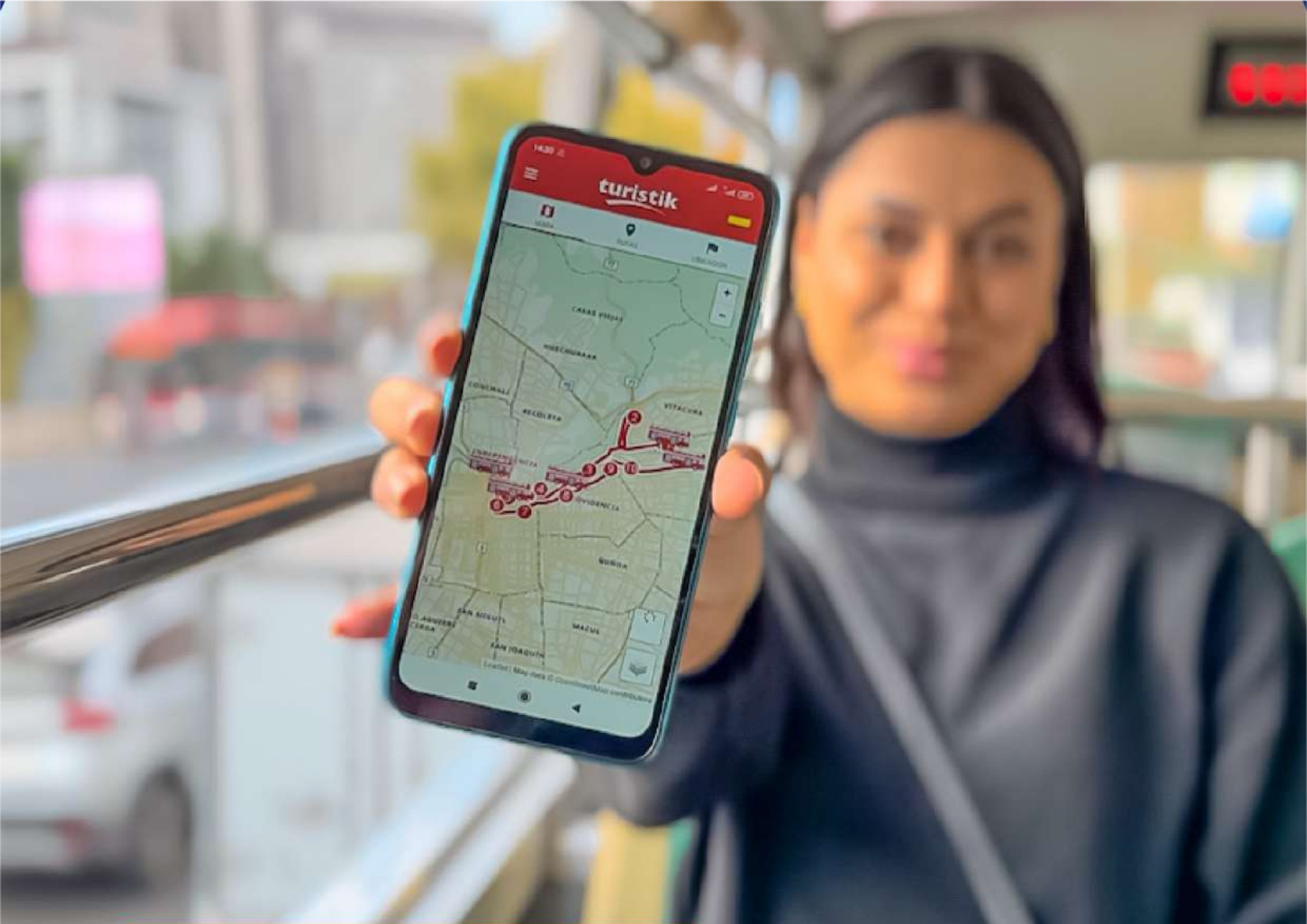

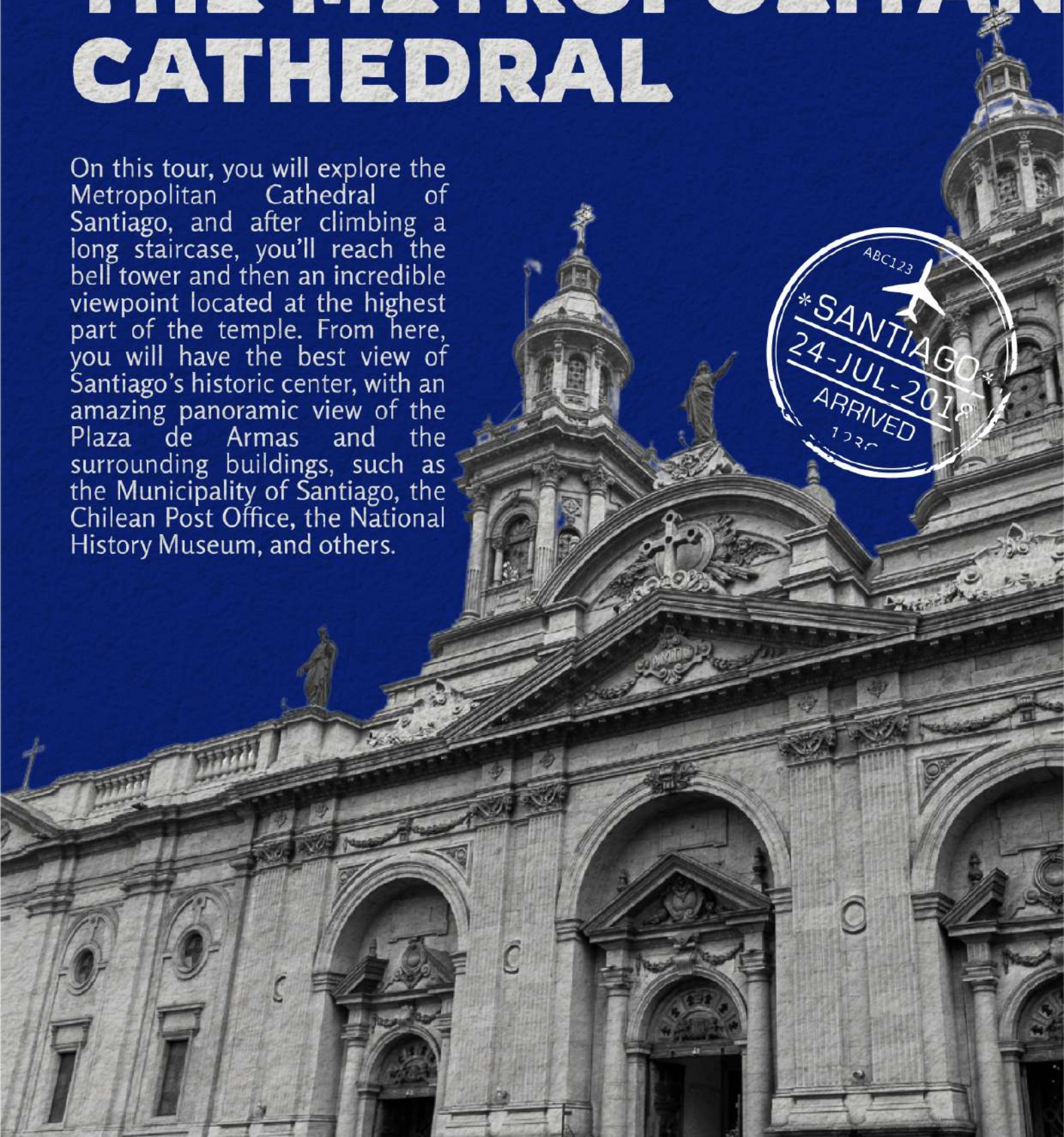

BELL TOWERS OF THE METROPOLITAN CATHEDRAL

On this tour, you will explore the Metropolitan Cathedral of Santiago, and after climbing a long staircase, you'll reach the bell tower and then an incredible viewpoint located at the highest part of the temple. From here, you will have the best view of Santiago's historic center, with an amazing panoramic view of the Plaza de Armas and the surrounding buildings, such as the Municipality of Santiago, the Chilean Post Office, the National History Museum, and others.



The history of the Metropolitan Cathedral dates back to 1745, when the construction of the current temple began, marking the fifth church built on this site, located in front of the Plaza de Armas. It was finally consecrated in 1775, and a few years later, Italian architect Joaquín Toesca was in charge of building the current facade. The Cathedral was declared a National Historic Monument of Chile on July 6, 1951.

SAFARI PARK TOUR



Safari Park is a center for the exhibition of native and exotic wildlife, located just over an hour from Santiago. The park offers various safari activities for both adults and children. If you would like to see lions, tigers, or giraffes in their habitat, you can't miss this incredible safari experience, where you can get up close and interact with these animals and other species aboard specially equipped vehicles for this activity.



This park also serves as a rehabilitation center for wildlife species such as birds of prey, tortoises, or sea lions, helping them recover so they can return to their natural habitats. Immerse yourself in the animal world with this Safari!

SANTA RITA VINEYARD TOUR

CLASSIC TOUR SANTA RITA

An experience through the cultural heritage and history of Chilean wine! This journey takes us to the Santa Rita Vineyard, located in the foothills just 45 minutes from Santiago, amidst vineyards with panoramic views of the Andes Mountains. We will visit the Centennial Park of Santa Rita, designed in a French style in 1883. Then, we will head to the winery that houses one of the oldest wines in Chile. We will end the winery visit with a tasting of three wines. Finally, we will visit the Andean Museum.

COUSIÑO MACUL VINEYARD & BAHÁ'Í TEMPLE TOUR



This tour starts with a visit to the Cousiño Macul Vineyard, founded in 1856, one of the oldest in the Maipo Valley. The architecture here is stunning, featuring a beautiful French style with stone foundations and brick vaults held together with mortar (made of lime, sand, and egg whites). You will enjoy a tour, learn about its history, and taste some exquisite wine varieties.

Next, we will visit the Bahá'í House of Worship, the first of its kind in South America. This imposing place stands out for its unique architecture and lighting, here you can connect with yourself in a calm and serene environment. Located in the foothills of the Andes, also gives you a spectacular panoramic view of Santiago.

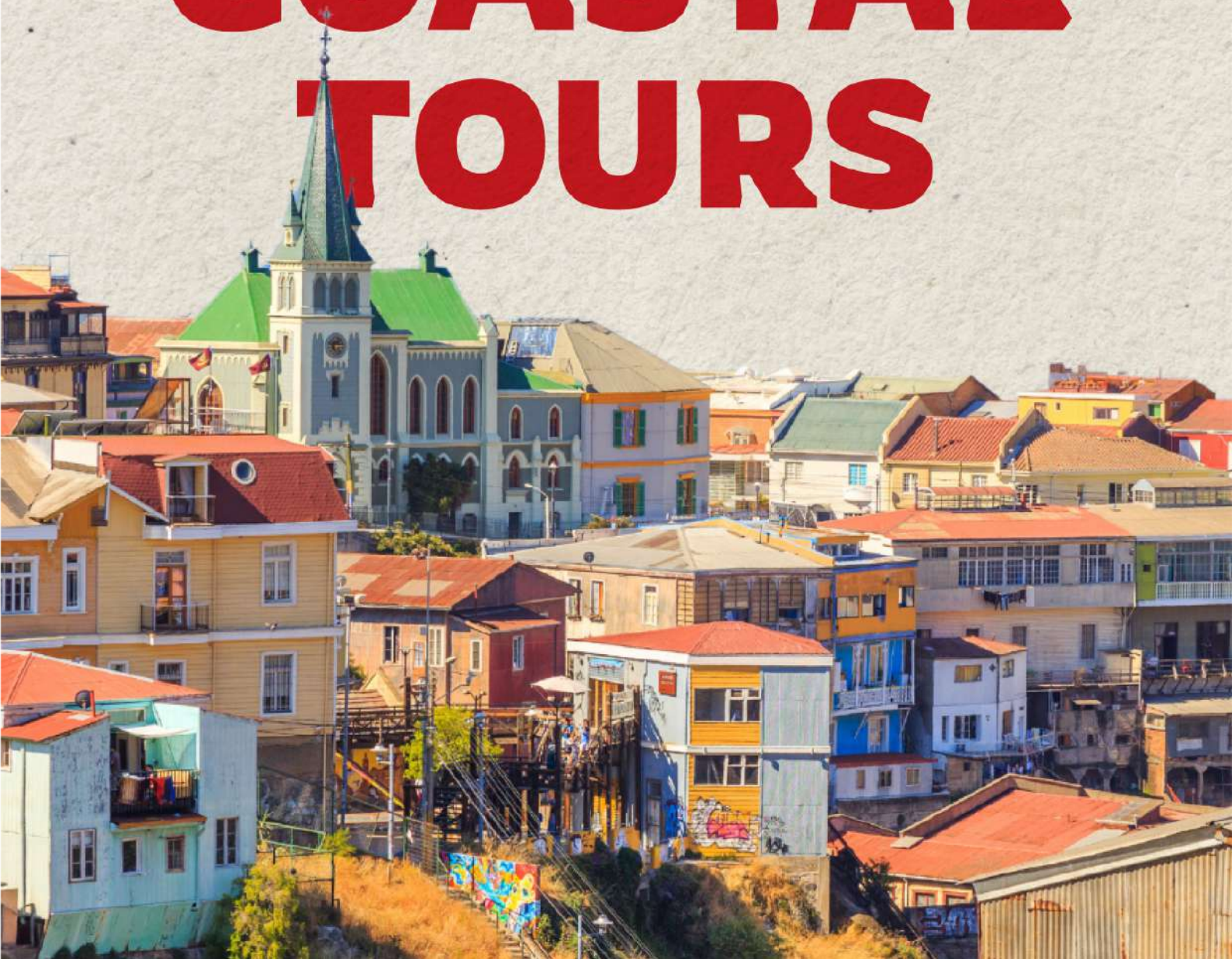

ISLA NEGRA, ALGARROBO & CASAS DEL BOSQUE VINEYARD TOUR



This experience begins in the Casablanca Valley, where we'll visit the Casas del Bosque Vineyard, a beautiful family-run vineyard listed among the World's Best Vineyards. Here, you'll have the opportunity to taste a variety of wines.

We'll then continue to the Pacific coast, heading to Algarrobo, one of Chile's most traditional beach resorts, where you can explore the coastal area, visit the Yacht Club, commonly known as the "Yachting," and its main attractions. Surrounded by a pine forest we'll arrive at San Alfonso del Mar, famous for having the world's largest swimming pool, where you can enjoy a spectacular view and have time for lunch on your own at "Peces Gordos Restaurant," renowned for its variety of seafood from the Chilean coast.

Next, we'll head to Isla Negra, a coastal town in central Chile with a beautiful and peaceful beach. This is also where the Isla Negra House Museum is located, where the renowned Chilean poet Pablo Neruda lived his last years of life. The museum preserves important collections, mainly related to the sea, such as replicas of sailing ships, ships in bottles, seashells, and more. After the visit, we'll head back to Santiago, having experienced the Central Coast of Chile, enjoyed fine wines, and had a unique lunch experience.
